

Heavenly Reflections II

TECHNIQUE SHEET 147

DH 1404 AGONY IN THE GARDEN

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Antiquing Solvent, & Chalk for blushing skin.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH8 Black, DH29 White, DH17 Flesh, DH2 Butter Cream, DH25 Toast, DH19 Light Grey, DH38 Grass Green, DH13 Petal Pink, DH37 Cream, DH9 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH30 Country Blue, DH14 Rose, AT2 Black Brown, AT5 Soft Brown.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Flesh; angel's hair Butter Cream; Jesus' hair, sandals & tree trunk, rocks Light Grey; grass Green; angel's dress Petal Pink; Jesus' clothes Cream; wings White.
Step 2: Antique rocks, Jesus' hair, grass and tree trunk with Black Brown. Antique remaining areas with Soft Brown. Wipe off excess stain with cloth dampened with antiquing solvent.
Step 3: Drybrush all areas with the same color they were basecoated with. Drybrush highlights to each area by adding a small amount of White to the base color and drybrushing the fabric folds, edges of rocks, grass edge, etc. Shade Jesus' hair, tree trunk and rocks with a wash of Real Brown. Shade between rows of feathers with a very thin wash of Rose, then a very thin wash of Country Blue. Paint angel's lips Rose. Paint Jesus' lips with a very thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint his eyes with Real Brown irises and Black pupils. Blush cheeks and skin with chalk.

DH1405 - GOOD SHEPHERD

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Spray Matte Fixative, Antiquing Solvent, Chalk for blushing skin.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH17 Flesh, DH8 Black, DH37 Cream, DH12 Leather Brown, DH25 Toast, DH9 Real Brown, DH18 Medium Brown, AT5 Soft Brown.

Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 05.
Step 2: Basecoat skin areas with Flesh. Basecoat inner robe with Cream, Antique with Soft Brown antiquing translucent and wipe with a cloth dampened with antiquing solvent. Drybrush inner robe again with Cream. Shade the folds of robe with Toast.
Step 3: Basecoat hair and beard with Real Brown and drybrush with Medium Brown. Basecoat rest of piece with Black.
Step 4: Drybrush outer robe and head drape with Leather Brown. Without rinsing your brush, add Toast and highlight robe. Drybrush staff with Real Brown and then Medium Brown. Paint rope belt with Leather Brown. Paint lips with a Leather Brown wash. Eyes are Medium Brown with a Black pupil. Shade outside robe with a Black wash. Blush cheeks with chalk and Spray with Matte Spray Fixative.

DH1406 - GUARDIAN ANGEL

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Antiquing Solvent.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH31 Leaf Green, DH17 Flesh, DH25 Toast, DH12 Leather Brown, DH13 Petal Pink, DH49 Premier Gold, DH37 Cream, DH8 DH36 Navy Blue, DH2 Butter Cream, DH49 Premier Gold, DH37 Cream, DH8 Black, DH18 Medium Brown, AT5 Soft Brown, Porcelain Spray Sealer, Matte Spray Sealer.

Step 1: Basecoat wings, pillow, angel's dress White. Basecoat all skin Flesh; hair Butter Cream; child's nightgown Petal Pink.
Step 2: Antique wings, hair, skin and pillow with Soft Brown. Wipe off excess stain carefully with solvent.
Step 3: Drybrush wings and pillow White. Touch-up dress with White, if necessary. Drybrush hair with Butter Cream; highlight lightly with Cream.
Step 4: Paint angel's eyes with Country Blue irises. Shade irises with Navy Blue. Paint pupils and lashes Black. Paint eyebrows with Medium Brown. Paint lips and fingernails with a wash of Rose.
Step 5: Shade nightgown with a thin wash of Rose. Paint ribbon on sleeve White. Paint blanket Rose. Shade folds and edges with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint right bear Toast. Lighten Toast with a little Cream and drybrush highlights on bear. Paint bottoms of arm and leg Cream. Shade bear with a wash of Leather Brown. Paint a Country Blue ribbon on his neck. Paint his eyes and nose Black. Paint a small pattern on the blanket and edge of pillow with Leaf Green and White.
Step 6: Shade the base of feather rows on wings with a very thin wash of Country Blue. Also shade the folds in the dress with this wash. Highlight the

ends of each row of feathers with White.
Step 7: Paint the chair Country Blue. Shade the cushions, cording and pleats with a Navy Blue wash. Use a liner brush if necessary to define the cordings.
Step 8: Paint neckline Premier Gold with tiny dots for decoration.

DH1407 - ST. FRANCIS

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Fixative, Antiquing Solvent, Doc's Glue.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH8 Black, DH17 Flesh, DH9 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH25 Toast, DH21 Sand, DH18 Medium Brown, DH37 Cream, DH29 White, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH2 Butter Cream, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH10 Mustard, DH26 Lexington Green, DH38 Grass Green, DH30 Country Blue, DH19 Light Grey, AT5 Soft Brown.

Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 05.
Step 2: Basecoat skin areas with Flesh. Antique with Soft Brown antiquing translucent. Wipe with cloth dampened with antiquing solvent.
Step 3: Basecoat rest of piece with Black. Drybrush everything except rocks with your brush, add a little Toast and highlight robe.
Step 4: Drybrush tree trunk, hair, beard, bird seed bowl and rabbit with Medium Brown. Lighten with Cream and highlight tree trunk and rabbit. Drybrush rabbit's cheeks, chest, tail and around ears with Cream.
Step 5: Drybrush grass and leaves on trunk with Lexington Green and then with Grass Green. Highlight with Mustard and then Toast. Drybrush rocks with Light Grey, add washes of Toast, Real Brown and Country Blue. Drybrush edges of rocks with Cream.
Step 6: Paint flowers Mystic Purple. Make a wash of Midnight Blue and add to center. Paint center of flower with Butter Cream.
Step 7: Paint coat on robe with Sand. Paint rabbit's eyes with Real Brown, add Black pupils. Paint bird seed using Medium Brown, Toast and Cream. Paint eyes Medium Brown with Black pupils. Shade robe and around rocks with Black.
Step 8: Basecoat birds Dark Grey. Drybrush bird White. Paint beaks Butter Cream. Shade around wings with Country Blue. (Refer to Flyer for using Doc's Glue.) Spray with Matte spray Fixative.

DH1408 - CRUCIFIXION

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Antiquing Solvent, Chalk for blushing skin, Doc's Glue.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH8 Black, DH9 Real Brown, DH18 Medium Brown, DH37 Cream, DH25 Toast, DH19 Light Grey, DH42 Dark Gray, DH30 Country Blue, DH12 Leather Brown, DH29 White, DH47 Silver, AT5 Soft Brown.

Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 05.
Step 2: Basecoat skin with Flesh. Basecoat cloth with Cream. Antique entire piece with Soft Brown. Wipe with soft cloth dampened with antiquing solvent. Basecoat crown on head Black. Drybrush with Leather Brown and highlight with Dark Grey. Drybrush cloth with Cream and shade folds with Toast. Paint lips with Leather Brown wash. Eyes are Medium Brown with Black pupil. Blush skin with chalk.
Step 3: Basecoat cross and rock base with Black. Drybrush cross with Real Brown and then again with Medium Brown. Highlight with Dark Grey. Paint all nails on cross with Silver.
Step 5: Drybrush rocks with Light Grey. Add washes of Toast, Real Brown, and Country Blue. Highlight edges of rocks with Cream. Shade around rocks with Black.
Step 6: Spray all pieces with Matte Spray Fixative. Glue Jesus to cross with Doc's Glue. When dry, glue cross to rock base.

Step 7: Paint the chair Country Blue. Shade the cushions, cording and pleats with a thin wash of Rose. Paint ribbon on sleeve White, if necessary to define the cordings.
Step 8: Spray with Matte Spray Fixative. Then spray faces and hair lightly with Porcelain Spray.

Step 9: Blush the skin with chalk.
Step 10: Spray with Matte Spray. Then spray faces and hair lightly with Porcelain Spray.

Step 1: Basecoat birds Dark Grey. Drybrush White. Shade around wings with County Blue. Paint beak Butter Cream and eyes Black.

Step 2: Paint neckline Premier Gold with tiny dots for decoration.

Step 3: Paint the skin with chalk.

Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray. Then spray faces and hair lightly with Porcelain Spray.


Step 5: Paint the chair Country Blue. Shade the cushions, cording and pleats with a thin wash of Rose. Paint ribbon on sleeve White, if necessary to define the cordings.

Step 6: Paint neckline Premier Gold with tiny dots for decoration.

Step 7: Paint the skin with chalk.

Step 8: Spray with Matte Spray. Then spray faces and hair lightly with Porcelain Spray.

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
