

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Cleaning Tools & Matte Spray Sealer.

**Doc Holiday Colors:** DH-8 Black, DH-10 Mustard, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-25 Toast, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-37 Cream, DH-29 White, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-28 Rust, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-14 Rose, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-42 Dark Grey, AT2 Black Brown Translucent, Gloss Spray Sealer.

### **MOUNTAIN LION – DH 1489**

Basecoat mountain lion Toast. Antique with Black Brown Translucent. Wipe off excess stain with soft cloth. Drybrush chest, belly, lower face and jaw, around eyes, and inside ears Cream. Drybrush remaining parts of lion Toast. Lighten Toast with a little Mustard and drybrush highlights on fur. Blend edges where Cream and Toast meet with a wash of Toast. Shade around legs, ears, forehead and cheeks with a Real Brown wash. Shade face markings with a Black wash (refer to photo). Paint eyes Mustard with Black pupils. Paint nose with a Leather Brown wash. Basecoat remaining areas Black. Drybrush rocks with Light Grey. Shade them with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Country Blue and Black. Lightly drybrush rocks with Cream to blend colors. Drybrush branches Real Brown. Highlight them by drybrushing first with Medium Brown, then lightly with Cream. Shade around branches with a Black wash to separate them from the rocks. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

### **WALRUSES – DH 1484 Mom, DH 1485 Dad, DH 1486 Baby**

Basecoat pieces (except tusks) with Real Brown. Antique with Black Translucent. Wipe off excess stain with soft cloth. Drybrush walrus with Real Brown; with same brush, add Medium Brown and drybrush walrus again, leaving muzzle and flippers dark. Add Black to same brush and drybrush flippers and muzzle, making them a dark grey color which fades into the lighter body color. Lightly drybrush body along neck and belly with Rose. Using a Black wash, shade ends of flippers, around arms and around mouth and tusks. Paint eyes Black. Paint

tusks Cream; shade upper portion with a wash of Medium Brown. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

### **OTTERS – DH 1487**

Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Apply washes of Toast, Real Brown, Country Blue and Black to rocks. Drybrush lightly with Cream to blend colors of washes. Drybrush all remaining areas Real Brown. Drybrush chest, muzzle, belly and around eyes with Cream. (Leave area on top and both sides of nose dark.) Paint nose, eyes and inside ears Black. Shade outer edges of Cream areas by drybrushing lightly with White. Drybrush dark areas of otters with Toast; with same brush, add a little Cream to lighten and drybrush highlights to body. Shade around arms, legs, bottom of tail, ends of feet and around nose with a Black wash. Drybrush grasses Grass Green; highlight with Mustard. Shade the grass leaves with a liner brush & Black. Shade around the rocks and otters with a Black wash.

### **MOOSE – DH 1491**

Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush entire piece with Real Brown. Drybrush moose again with Medium Brown. With color still in your brush add Cream to lighten color and drybrush highlights on moose's body and very heavily on antlers. Make the antler tips and around the nostrils very light. Shade the base of antlers and tops of hooves with a wash of Real Brown. Then shade the base of antlers lightly with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint the eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Drybrush inside the ears Cream. Using a thin wash of Black, shade the recessed areas of the body (around legs, tail, hooves, cheeks, ears, ankles and etc.) and down the back and neck. Make the upper ridge of back lower edge of neck very dark. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Shade them with washes of Toast, Country Blue and Real Brown. Drybrush them lightly with Cream. Highlight branch and stump with Toast. Drybrush grass with Grass Green; add Mustard to same brush and drybrush highlights on grass to same brush add Toast and drybrush lower parts of grass. Shade around stump, branch, rocks and deepest sections of grass with a Black wash. Paint the small leaves Leather Brown. Highlight them first with Christmas Red,

then Rust. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

### **ICEBERG BASE – DH 1490**

Basecoat White. Apply a thin wash of Country Blue over entire base. Shade cracks and ridges with Country Blue. (Corner load your brush.) Shade lightly with a very thin wash of Mystic Purple. Drybrush iceberg heavily with White. Spray 3-4 coats of Gloss Spray Sealer, letting each coat dry thoroughly.

### **POLAR BEARS – DH 1483**

Basecoat bears White, paint nose, eyes and feet pads Black. Shade inside ears and around nose with a Black wash. Line mouth with Black.



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
