

DH-1684 DEER

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Cleaner/Solvent.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-25 Toast, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-21 Sand, DH-37 Cream, DH-10 Mustard, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-02 Butter Cream, DH-12 Leather Brown, AT-02 Black Brown Translucent.

Step 1: Basecoat deer with Toast. Antique with Black Brown Translucent. Wipe excess stain with Cleaner/Solvent. Wet-brush "white" areas of deer with Cream. Highlight with White. Wet-brush remaining areas with Toast. With color still in your brush, add Mustard and wet-brush highlights on fur. Tint the deer's back, shoulders and forehead with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Shade the deer with a Black wash. Paint hooves and nose Black. Paint eyes Toast with Black pupils.

Step 2: Basecoat remaining areas Black.
Step 3: Wet-brush over Black with Real Brown. Add Toast to same brush and wet-brush highlights on logs; repeat with Sand, then Cream. Shade logs with washes of Leather Brown & Black.

Step 4: Wet-brush the leaves Grass Green. Add Mustard to same brush and highlight leaves. Add Butter Cream and highlight further. Shade darker areas of leaves with Shadow Green. Shade leaves with Black and line where necessary to define and separate leaves.
Step 5: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1676 Wolf

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, P-400 Solvent, Matte Spray Sealer.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-25 Toast, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-37 Cream, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-45 Shadow Green, AT-01 Black Translucent.

Step 1: Basecoat wolf Light Grey. Antique with Black Translucent. Wipe off excess color with cloth dampened with solvent.

Step 2: Basecoat remaining areas Black.
Step 3: Wet-brush the rocks and wolf with Light Grey. Tint the rocks with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Country Blue and Black. Lightly wet-brush the rocks with Cream to highlight and blend colors.

Step 4: Wet-brush the log, leaves and grass with Real Brown. With color still in your brush, add Toast and wet-brush log again. Still with same brush, add Country Blue and wet-brush highlights on the log. Add a little Cream to same brush and highlight edges of log. Wet-brush the leaves and grass Grass Green. Add Mustard to same brush and highlight leaves and grass. Add Cream to same brush and highlight edges of leaves and tips of grasses. Lightly tint some of the grass with a Toast wash. Shade the bases of leaves with a wash of Shadow Green. Shade log, rock crevices, leaves and grasses with a Black wash. Paint Black veins in the leaves.

Step 5: Apply a very light wash of Medium Brown to wolf's face and edges of areas that will be light (backs of legs, neck, sides). Apply a wash of Black on fur to darken it to a dark grey. Apply several coats of the Black wash to shade and define fur and muscles. Shade face, around eyes, forehead and around ears with a Black wash also. Paint eyes Mustard, with Black pupils and White highlight. Paint nose and lips Black.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1679 Indian Angel with Deer

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Ultra Fine Glitter, Matte Spray Sealer, Chalk.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-07 Dark Flesh, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-37 Cream, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-02 Butter Cream, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-25 Toast, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-10 Mustard, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, AT-02 Black Brown Translucent, SP-03 Gloss-I.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Dark Flesh. Basecoat dress and headband Flaxon Yellow. Antique skin and dress with Red Brown Translucent.

Step 2: Paint deer as instructed for Deer - DH-1684.

Step 3: Wet-brush dress lightly with Flaxon Yellow. Add Cream to same brush and wet-brush fringe, making the ends very light. Apply a Midnight Blue wash to beadwork on dress. Paint bead pattern using White, Turquoise and Terra Cotta. Paint dots for beads on headband with White, Turquoise and Terra Cotta. Paint earrings Terra Cotta.
Step 4: Basecoat wings Cream. Tint upper third of wing sections with a wash of Butter Cream. Shade between wing sections with a Turquoise wash. Wet-brush leather ends with White. Paint hair and eyebrows Black. Paint lips with a Leather Brown wash. Paint eyes Medium Brown, outlined with Real Brown and Black pupils and lashes. Shade feathers on earrings with a Terra Cotta wash. Blush skin with Chalk.

Step 5: Tint clouds with a wash of Blue Suede.

Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

Step 7: Apply Gloss-I to clouds; while still wet, sprinkle with Glitter.

DH-1677 Indian Angel with Buffalo

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Ultra Fine Glitter, Matte Spray Sealer, Chalk.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-07 Dark Flesh, DH-37 Cream, DH-51 Mauve, DH-52 Cranberry, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-18

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Medium Brown, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-12 Leather Brown, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, AT-05 Soft Brown Translucent, SP-03 Gloss-I.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Dark Flesh. Basecoat buffalo, necklaces and wings Cream. Antique skin and necklace with Red Brown Translucent. Antique buffalo with Soft Brown Translucent. Basecoat clouds White.

Step 2: Basecoat dress and base Mauve. With color still in your brush, add a little Cream and wet-brush highlights on folds of dress and fringe. Wet-brush ends of fringe with White. Shade upper 1/3 of fringe with a Mauve wash, followed lightly with a Cranberry wash. Paint beadwork pattern on dress using Turquoise, White and a Cranberry wash.

Step 3: Shade feathers with a Mauve wash. Wet-brush the ends of feathers with White. Paint earrings and headband Mauve, with Turquoise and White "beads." Paint beads on necklace Turquoise.

Step 4: Tint clouds with washes of Country Blue and Mauve.

Step 5: Wet-brush buffalo with Cream; highlight with White. Shade horns, muzzles, eyes, etc. with a Medium Brown wash; paint eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. **Step 6:** Paint eyes with Medium Brown iris; outlined with Real Brown and Black lashes, eyebrows and pupils. Paint lips with a wash of Leather Brown. Paint hair Black. Blush skin with Chalk.

Step 7: Spray lightly with Matte Spray Sealer.

Step 8: Apply Gloss-I to clouds; while still wet, sprinkle with Glitter.

DH-1675 Bear with Cubs

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-21 Sand, DH-25 Toast, DH-10 Mustard, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-01 Daffodil, DH-03 True Orange, DH-37 Cream.

Step 1: Wet-brush rocks Light Grey.

Step 2: Wet-brush bears with Real Brown. With same brush, add Medium Brown and wet-brush bears again. Wet-brush muzzles with Sand. Highlight fur by wet-brushing with Toast mixed with Mustard, then very lightly with Sand. Paint claws Light Grey.

Step 3: Shade around muzzles with a wash of Real Brown. Shade bears with a Black wash.

Step 4: Paint a thin Medium Brown line under each eye. Paint eyes Black with White highlight. Paint noses Black.

Step 5: Tint rocks with washes of Toast, Leather Brown and Real Brown. Wet-brush

the rocks with Cream to highlight and blend colors.
Step 6: Wet-brush grass and leaves Grass Green. With color still in your brush, add increasing amounts of Mustard and highlight grass and leaves. Add Butter Cream to same brush and highlight edges of leaves' tips and tips of grasses. Shade leaves' centers with Shadow Green wash. Lightly tint some of the leaves with a thin Toast wash.

Step 7: Shade flowers Daffodil. Shade flower centers with a wash of True Orange. **Step 7:** Shade flowers, grasses, crevices in rocks, around bears and around grasses and leaves with a Black wash. Use a liner to paint Black veins in the leaves and outline leaves and grasses where needed.

Step 8: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1647 Indian Angel with Bear

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Chalk.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-43 Teal, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-37 Cream, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-25 Toast, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-07 Dark Flesh, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-21 Sand, DH-02 Butter Cream, SP-02 Mask-I, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, AT-01 Black Translucent.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Dark Flesh. Basecoat necklace Cream. Antique with Red Brown Translucent. Paint lips with a wash of Leather Brown. Paint eyes Medium Brown, rimmed with Real Brown; Black pupils and lashes; Real Brown eyelashes. Blush skin with Chalk.

Step 2: Basecoat base Blue Suede. Basecoat wings Cream. Shade between wing sections with a wash of Blue Suede.

Step 3: Basecoat all remaining areas Black. Wet-brush bear with Real Brown; add Medium Brown to same brush and wet-brush highlights; repeat by adding Sand, making the muzzle lightest. Darken Real Brown with Black and use to paint nose. Paint eyes Black with a very thin lower rim of Medium Brown.

Step 4: Wet-brush the rocks Light Grey. Shade rocks with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Black and Blue Suede. Highlight lightly with Cream.

Step 5: Wet-brush dress with Blue Suede. Add a small amount of Cream to same brush and highlight the folds. Add more Cream to same brush and wet-brush all the fringe. Shade deepest folds of dress and top and bottom of base with a teal wash. Shade upper part of fringe with a wash of Blue Suede. Shade necklace fringe with a thin wash of Toast. Wet-brush beads on belt and bracelet with Turquoise. Apply a wash of Midnight Blue over the turquoise. Paint a thin line of Toast on upper edge of necklace fringe. Highlight ends of fringe and necklace and earrings with Cream. Paint

"beads" on belt, bracelet, necklace, earrings neckline with dots of Turquoise, Christmas Red and Butter Cream.

Step 6: Apply Mask-I to Fired Silver areas (if used). Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-I.

DH-1645 Indian Angel with Wolf

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-23 Bone, DH-10 Mustard, DH-51 Mauve, DH-52 Cranberry, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-42 Dark Grey, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-37 Cream, DH-07 Dark Flesh, DH-12 Leather Brown, SP-02 Mask-I, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, AT-01 Black Translucent.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Dark Flesh; necklace Cream; dress Bone; rocks and base Dark Grey; wolf Light Grey.

Step 2: Antique skin and dress with Red Brown Translucent and wolf with Black Translucent.

Step 3: Basecoat wings Cream. Shade between wing sections with Mauve. Wet-brush ends of feathers with White to highlight.

Step 4: Wet-brush wolf with Light Grey. Shade wolf's fur and face with washes of Medium Brown, Dark Grey and Black. Paint eyes Mustard with Black pupils; paint nose Black. Highlight fur lightly with Cream.

Step 5: Wet-brush fringe with Bone; wet-brush the ends of fringe with Cream. Shade upper third of fringe with a Mauve wash.

Step 6: Paint beads on necklace Turquoise. Apply a wash of Midnight Blue over the turquoise. Paint upper third of beadwork on dress Blue Suede; shade with a wash of Midnight Blue. Paint center third of beadwork White. Paint bottom third of beadwork Mauve; apply a wash of Cranberry over the Mauve. Lightly wet-brush the necklace with Cream. Decorate with dots of Turquoise and Cranberry. Paint her lips with a wash of Leather Brown. Paint her eyes with Medium Brown iris (outlined with Real Brown) and Black pupils, lashes and eyebrows. Paint her hair Black. Blush cheeks with Chalk. Paint a narrow line of Cranberry on dress at base of fringe.

Decorate with dots of Turquoise and White for beads.

Step 7: Wet-brush rocks Light Grey. Shade with washes of Cranberry, Mauve, Blue Suede and Dark Grey. Highlight by wet-brushing lightly with Cream.

Step 8: "Smack-dab" the base with a mixture of Mauve and Dark Grey to create a "matte" look. Use a wash of Cranberry to paint "veins" in the base.

Step 9: Apply Mask-I to any Fired-On Silver areas (if used). Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-I. Fired-On Silver may be used for rim around base, earrings and center of necklace, if desired. If not used, paint earrings to match beads on necklace and paint rim of base Dark Grey.

DH-1678 Indian Angel on Mustang

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Chalk, Soft Cloth.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-09 Real Brown, DH-07 Dark Flesh, DH-29 White, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-37 Cream, DH-08 Black, DH-51 Mauve, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-14 Rose, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-05 Purple, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, SP-02 Mask-I.

Step 1: Basecoat mustang Real Brown. Basecoat Indian Angel skin with Dark Flesh. Basecoat Indian Angel's dress and wings White. Antique all basecoated pieces with Red Brown Translucent and wipe off with a soft cloth.

Step 2: Drybrush mustang with Medium Brown. Highlight with Flaxon Yellow. Paint mane and hair around mustang's legs with Flaxon Yellow and highlight with Cream. Shade the muscles, leg joints, ears, hair and face with a Black wash. Paint hooves Black and paint a Black wash on muzzle. Paint Cream marking on face. Eyes are Cream with Black pupils.

Step 3: Drybrush Angel's dress and wings White. Shade dress and fringe with Medium Brown. Shade wings with Mauve and Blue Suede. Drybrush wings softly with White to blend colors.

Step 4: Paint beads with Turquoise, Midnight Blue and White. Paint feathers on earrings and necklace with same colors. Paint headband with White and decorate with beads using Turquoise and Midnight Blue. Paint hair Black. Paint iris' Real Brown and pupils Black. Paint lips with Leather Brown. Chalk cheeks to add color.

Step 5: Paint clouds with washes of Rose, Country Blue and Purple. Add heavy color of White on clouds blending in the colors. Shade clouds with Country Blue. Paint base with Country Yellow.

Step 6: Apply Mask-I to Fired-On Silver areas and spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1674 Cougar

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Soft Cloth.
Doc Holiday Colors: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-10 Mustard, DH-25 Toast, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-14 Rose, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-37 Cream, AT-02 Black Brown Translucent.

Step 1: Basecoat cougar Mustard and Antique with Black Brown Translucent. Wipe off with a Soft Cloth.

Step 2: Wet-brush cougar with Flaxon Yellow. Tint fur with a thin wash of Toast. Tint top of cougar's back and belly with a thin wash of Real Brown. Paint in "White" markings on face, feet and belly with cream. Shade cougar's muscle tone areas with Real Brown. Paint eyes with Mustard and Black pupils and White highlight. Paint nose Rose, then shade it with Black.

Step 3: Basecoat rocks Black. Wet-brush rocks with Country Blue, Mustard and Toast. Wet-brush rocks lightly with Cream to highlight and blend colors.

Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.
