## HOT DRAGON DESIGNS™

### TECHNIQUE SHEET 172

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Soft Cloth, Matte Spray Sealer, P-400 Solvent, Rhinestones, Brush on Glitter: Red, Blue, Black, Clear, Light Turquoise, Gold & Pink, Blue Purple, Pink, Yellow, Lavender & Green, Pearl Stains: Orchid, White, Gold & Pink, Blue Ceramichrome Gold Glorious Glitter, Glazes: Clear, Black, Liquid Gold, Liquid Silver.

**DOC HOLIDAY CLOTHES:** DH-10 Mustard, DH-12 Lemon Brown, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-37 Cream, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-12 Leaf Green, DH-03 True Orange, DH-37 Cream, Navy Blue, DH-29 White, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-15 Medium Brown, DH-08 Real Brown, DH-23 Bone, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-01 Daffodil, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-09 Pearl White, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-21 Sand, DH-51 Mauve, DH-42 Dark Grey, SP-04 Snow-it, FT-02 Fingertip, SP-02 Mask-it, SP-05 Doc's Glue, FT-03 Green Mist FingerTip, FT-01 Silver Fingertip, SP-01 Texture-It, Weathered Wood.

**NOTE:** For all Gold areas, apply 2 coats of Clear Gloss Glaze to bisque. Fire to Cone 05. Apply Liquid Gold (or Silver) to glazed area. Fire to Cone 016-019. Clean any paint off Fired-On Gold areas with a cloth dampened with water.

#### DH-1701 SMALL FALL DRAGON

**Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece except Gold, Black.  
**Step 2:** Wet-brush rocks, brick and stone sections of castle with Light Grey.  
**Step 3:** Wet-brush dragon with Teal. With color still in your brush, add increasing amounts of Turquoise to wet-brush the dragon's body, wings and face. Make the areas near the Gold belly, tops of wings, toes, knees and face the lightest color. Add a little White to your wing ends, ankles, near end of tail, along ridges on back and lightly between wing bones. Make the ends of wings lighter by adding a little White to the Mystic Purple. Wet-brush Purple to same brush and highlight same areas of body and wings. Add more Mystic Purple and wet-brush wing tips, belly, back ridges, faces, etc. highlight these areas by adding White. Paint tongue Red, eyes Daffodil, teeth and claws Premier Gold. Shade dragon with Mauve wash. Paint with a comb-loaded Black wash. Line with Black where necessary, around gold areas, toes, etc.  
**Step 4:** Shade the dragon with a Midnight Blue wash. Use photo or sample as guide.  
**Step 5:** Shade piece with a corner-loaded Black wash. Use a liner where necessary, around fins, gills on face, along edges of Gold belly, around Gold toes, etc.  
**Step 6:** Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.  
**Step 7:** Paint with washes of Mystic Purple, Teal and Midnight Blue. Wet brush lightly with Cream to blend colors.  
**Step 8:** Paint with washes of Mauve, Black and White. Paint with a comb-loaded Black wash. Use photo or sample as guide.  
**Step 9:** Shade piece with a corner-loaded Black wash. Use a liner where necessary, around fins, gills on face, along edges of Gold belly. Paint teeth White.

**Step 10:** Apply Green Mist Finger Tip metallic to ridges on back with your finger. Moisten a brush with P-400 Solvent and use to apply the metallic in small areas. Apply the metallic so it looks solid.  
**Step 11:** Using a brush moistened with P-400 Solvent, apply Finger Tip Gold to doors, teeth and smooth upper areas of castle.  
**Step 12:** Apply Mystic Blue Brush-On Glitter to tops of wings, on body and face to highlight.  
**Step 13:** Glue Rhinestones in eyes.

#### DH-1699 SMALL SPRING DRAGON

**Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Tint them with washes of Cranberry and Leather Brown. Shade deepest areas and around dragon with a Black wash. Drybrush dragon (except belly and back on back), with Mauve. Highlight by drybrushing with a little White mixed with Mauve. Drybrush belly and back ridge with Blue. Shade with a wash of Midnight Blue. Shades Mauve areas with a Cranberry wash. Paint highlights and accents on face and belly ridges with White. Drybrush eggs Blue Suede. Shade them with a Midnight Blue wash, then a Black wash. Paint Premier Gold dots on eggs. Drybrush tree Root Brown. With color still in your brush, add Toast and drybrush highlights on tree. Drybrush smooth areas of tree with Sand. Shade and tint these areas with washes of Toast. Leather town and black. Shade around tee and dragon with a Black wash. Paint mouth Cranberry, teeth Gold and eyes Daffodil.  
**Step 2:** Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Highlight pink areas of dragon with Pink Pearl Stain. Highlight White Pearl Stain. Apply Pink Brush-On Glitter to wings. Glue Rhinestones in eyes.

#### DH-1700 SMALL SUMMER DRAGON

**Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush rocks Bone. Tint rocks with washes of Cranberry and Country Blue. Drybrush rocks again with Cream; shade crevices with a Black wash. Drybrush coral with Peach. Apply a thin wash of Cranberry over the Peach; let dry, then highlight edges lightly with Daffodil. Drybrush shells White. Shade lat shell with a wash of Cranberry, making the edges of each shell the lightest. Tint other shells with a thin wash of Midnight Blue.  
**Step 2:** Drybrush dragon with Leaf Green. With color still in your dragon, add increasing amounts of Daffodil and drybrush highlights on the dragon. Make around the face, feet and hair on neck very yellow. Shade around face, fins, toes and Gaud areas with a wash of Midnight Blue. Paint tongue, eye and ridges on neck Cranberry. Paint teeth Bone.  
**Step 3:** Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.  
**Step 4:** Paint Daffodil Pearl Stain on sides and around face of dragon. Drybrush edges of shells and randomly on rocks with White Pearl Stain. Paint Cranberry ridges on neck with Red Brush-On Glitter. Paint darker parts of dragon with Green Brush-On Glitter. Paint light parts and around face with Yellow Brush-On Glitter. Glue a Rhinestone in eye.

#### DH-1702 SMALL WINTER DRAGON

**Step 1:** Basecoat ice White. Shade ice with a thin wash of Country Blue, allowing the most color to stay in the crevices. Shade just the crevices and base of ice sticks with a thin wash of Midnight Blue. Tint the ice lightly with washes of Mystic Purple and Turquoise. Drybrush the ice with White to blend the colors. Make edges and tops of ice very White.  
**Step 2:** Paint with washes of Blue, Black, White and Gold. Paint with a wash of Medium Brown, Blue wash. Wet-brush tunic and hat. Turquoise; shade with Midnight beard Real Brown.  
**Step 3:** Rider - Paint his skin Soft Brown. Shade skin with a wash of Medium Brown. Wet-brush legs. Wet-brush tights Leather Tan. Paint him on tunic Christmas Red. Paint and ridges of tree. Shade crevices with a Black wash. Line with a wash of Medium Brown.  
**Step 4:** Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.  
**Step 5:** Apply Purple Brush-On Glitter to wing edges and Blue Suede areas of face.  
**Step 6:** Glue on rider with Doc's Glue.

### DH-1686 GRAND DRAGON WITH TREASURE

**Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black.  
**Step 2:** Apply 1 coat Weathered Wood to belly areas. Let dry, then apply 1 heavy coat of Mystic Purple over it. Shade sides and crevices with a Midnight Blue wash.  
**Step 3:** Wet-brush remaining parts of dragon with Turquoise. Wet-brush edges of wings, toes, knees and face with Mystic Purple. Add a little White to same wash and wet brush highlights to these areas. Paint tongue Christmas Red. Shade dragon with a Midnight Blue wash to blend and deepen the colors. Shade deepest recessed areas of dragon with a Black wash.  
**Step 4:** Wet-brush as if for 2 headed dragon except use Mystic Purple instead of Orange to tint them. Paint treasure chest Toast; paint lines for wood with Black.  
**Step 5:** Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.  
**Step 6:** Dampen brush with P-400 Solvent and use to apply Finger Tip Gold on detail area of wings and gold in treasure chest.  
**Step 7:** Apply Blue Brush-On Glitter to dragon as desired.

#### DH-1648 DRAGON & CASTLE & DH-1685 DOUBLE DRAGON HEAD

**Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black.  
**Step 2:** Wet-brush rocks and castle Light Grey. Tint castle with a wash of Sand. Highlight around windows and doors by wet-brushing with Cream. Shade and tint the rocks with washes of Toast, Orange, Country Blue and Black. Lightly wet-brush the rocks with Cream, brush, add increasing amounts of Mustard and wet-brush highlights on the body, face and feet. Paint tongue Christmas Red. Paint gills and eyes Turquoise.  
**Step 3:** Wet-brush all the "green" parts of dragon with Grass Green. With color still in your mouth, add increasing amounts of Mustard and wet-brush highlights on the body, face and feet. Paint tongue Christmas Red. Paint gills and eyes Turquoise.  
**Step 4:** Shade recessed areas of dragon with a Shadow Green wash, followed by a Black wash in the deepest areas. Paint teeth Bone. Paint a Black pupil in eyes with Black. Line around Gold areas, around gills, eyes, etc. as necessary to sharpen detail.  
**Step 5:** Rub on Green Mist Finger Tip wax metallic on wings. Rub on Silver wax metallic on upper and lower edges of wings and on scales on back. Apply Black Glitter to plain areas of castle and dragon's collar.  
**Orang wash.**

#### DH-2221 SUMMER VASE & DH-2207 - OIL LAMP

**Step 1:** Fire greenware to Cone 03.  
**Step 2:** Glaze inside with Black Glaze and fire to Cone 05.  
**Step 3:** Mix the texture it with Black Stain and brush on pots.  
**Step 4:** Drybrush Midnight Blue heavy on pots first, then the teal then Mystic Purple.  
**Step 5:** Use Gold Glorious Glitter for designs and around the edges. Two coats will be needed.

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
