DH1743 - Fishing Frame (5" x 7")
Materials and Colors: greenware, DH04 True Red, DH08 Black, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH20 Sky Blue, DH25 Toast, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, DH47 Silver, SP08 Matte Spray

Step 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.
Step 2: Basecoat frame Black. Webbrush frame with Toast and highlight with Flaxon Yellow. Shade with Black.
Step 3: Paint fish White and paint Grass Green on top of fish and fins. Webbrush Mustard over Grass Green and shade with Black. Paint bucket with Silver and water Country Blue. Paint Red stripe on bucket.
Step 4: Paint netting Cream and floats on netting True Red. Paint fishing poles Leather Brown, Flaxon Yellow, True Red and White. Paint box Leather Brown and highlight with Toast. Paint string with White. Paint water Sky Blue and grass Grass Green.
Step 5: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

Textured Relief Animal Frames - 2537-Horse (4" x 6"), 2533 Elk (8.5" x 6.75"), 2535 Wolf (6.5" x 6.75"), 2534 Duck (6.5" x 6.75")

Materials and Colors: greenware, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH21 Sand, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH38 Grass Green, SP08 Matte Spray
All frames - basecoat Black. Webbrush with Real Brown (leaving silhouettes Black).
Horse - webbrush with Leather Brown. Highlight with Toast.
Elk - webbrush with Toast. Highlight with Sand.
Wolf - webbrush with Grass Green. Highlight with Mustard.
Ducks - webbrush with Toast. With color still in your brush, add Country Blue to make a greyish color to highlight with.
All frames - touch up silhouettes with Black as needed. Spray with Matte Spray.

DH2560 Bears (3 per mold, 5.5") & DH2548 Tart Burner Base (1" x 6.5")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH21 Sand, DH25 Toast, AT03 True Brown Antiquing Translucent, SP08 Matte Spray
Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Black. Using Real Brown, Leather Brown, Toast and Sand, "streak" wood grain effect on base.
Step 2: Antique bears with True Brown translucent.
Step 3: Webbrush bears (except muzzles) with Black. Highlight fur around feet, on belly, inside ears, and muzzle with Real Brown. Highlight again with Toast, followed by Sand. Shade around muzzles with a Black wash.
Step 4: Paint nose and footpads Black. Paint eyes with Toast iris, Black pupils. Spray with Matte Spray.

PK104 Horse Picture Frame (5" x 7")
Materials and Colors: greenware, DH08 Black, DH24 Terra Cotta, DH29 White, DH37 Cream, AT03 True Brown Antiquing

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to cone 03. Basecoat entire piece using White. Use Black to shade around muzzle, eyes, and inside ears. This should be subtle.
Step 2: Antique entire piece with AT03 True Brown antiquing. Brush on some dark color in the low areas.
Step 3: Webbrush entire piece with Cream to bring out highlights, making sure not to lose Black shading. To bring out eyes mix a few drops each of Terra Cotta and Toast. Carefully paint a small crescent on the lower half of eyeball with this color. A small spot of White just under the upper lid will give the eye a "live" appearance. Spray piece with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2538 Cow Girl (13.5" x 8") & DH1363 Trail Boss(14" T) AND DH2501 and DH2502 African Masks

Materials and Colors: bisque, DH65 Roughcut Bronze, AT01 Black Translucent, FT02 Fingertip Gold, FT04 Fingertip Burnished Gold, FT05 Fingertip Copper, SP08 Matte Spray, (optional - clear glaze and fired-on gold)
Apply two coats of clear glaze to areas you want with fired gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply liquid gold and fire to cone 018.
Step 1: Basecoat entire piece with Roughcut Bronze. Antique entire piece with Black Translucent. Work on a small area at a time so translucent does not dry out before you wipe the excess away. Let dry.
Step 2: Apply Fingertip Gold, Burnished Gold, and Copper as desired for a metallic effect. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2518 Giraffe Oval Plaque (8" x 6")
Materials and Colors: bisque, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, SP08

Matte Spray, solvent

Step 1: Basecoat entire top of surface of plaque with Bone
Step 2: Shade and tint the woodgrain areas with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Leather Brown and Black (just around edge), following the direction of the woodgrain as you apply washes

Step 3: Corner-load B6-1/2" shader with Black and float color around edges of animal cutouts and around prominent areas of animal.
Step 4: Antique top surface of plaque with Black translucent. Wipe away excess stain from wood grain areas with cloth dampened with solvent. Leave the animals a little dark.

Step 5: Paint outer edge of plaque Black. Webbrush with Real Brown. With same brush, add Toast and highlight wood. Add a little Bone to same brush and highlight more.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2489 Giraffe Rock(5.5" x 4"), DH2517 Elephant Rock (4" x 5.5")

Materials and Colors:: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray sealer
Step 1: Basecoat rock with Black. Webbrush Mustard, Country Blue, Toast and Real Brown with washes on rock portion only.
Step 2: Webbrush entire piece with Light Grey and highlight with Cream. Shade creviced areas with Black.
Step 3: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2531 Bamboo Frame (5" x 7")

Materials and Colors: bisque, DH25 Toast, DH37 Cream, AT05 Soft Brown Antiquing, SP08 Matte Spray
Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Cream. Antique with Soft Brown antiquing translucent. Wipe back more with solvent if needed.
Step 2: Float Toast in creviced areas and along edges of frame. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2541 Votive Daisies (5" x 3") & DH2542 Votive Roses (5" x 3")

Materials and Colors: DH01 Daifodil, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH38 Grass Green, DH45 Shadow Green, DH52 Cranberry, SP08 Matte Spray
Step 1: Basecoat entire piece White. Tint leaves with a wash of Grass Green. Shade them with a wash of Shadow Green.
Step 2: Tint flowers with a Midnight Blue wash. Tint roses with a Cranberry wash. Paint flower centers Daifodil. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2539 Starfish Votive Holder (1" x 4")

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece with DH25 Toast. Highlight with DH21 Sand.

DH2550 Dolphins (3 per mold, 5.5") & DH2548 Tart Burner Base (1" x 6.5")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH42 Dark Gray, SP07 Krackle-It
Step 1: Basecoat base Midnight Blue. Apply one coat of Krackle-It over the Midnight Blue. Let dry. Apply one coat Country Blue over Krackle-It. Let dry. Paint center carole area White.
Step 2: Basecoat dolphins Dark Gray. Add increasing amounts of White to your brush to lighten color and webbrush dolphins. Webbrush belly's White. Paint eyes Black.

DH2547 Fisherman Frame (4" x 6")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH14 Rose, DH25 Toast, DH26 Lexington Green, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, DH47 Silver, SP08 Matte Spray
Step 1: Basecoat frame Black. Webbrush dark areas and wicker bag with Real Brown, then Toast, then highlight aged bark areas with Country Blue and wicker bag. Tint wood with a wash of Leather Brown. Re-apply Toast to your brush and lighten with Cream to highlight barkless areas and wicker bag. Tint wood with a wash of Leather Brown.
Step 2: Webbrush Leather Brown on straps of bag and lure. Webbrush fish and lure and fishing pole handle with Lexington Green. Add Cream and highlight fish scales, gills and tail, fishing pole and fins.
Step 3: Webbrush Cream on belly of fish and upper gills, fins and face area, add Rose and highlight face and stripe above belly. Paint stripes on lure with White, highlight with White and eyeball with White.
Paint a Black pupil with White highlight. Webbrush silver on reel of fishing pole. Paint hooks and lines and buckles with Silver.
Step 4: Tint wicker bag with a wash of Toast. Shade with a Black wash to redefine detail. Spray with Matte Spray.

DH2552 Lions (3 per mold, 5.5") & DH2548 Tart Burner Base (1" x 6.5")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH21 Sand, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, AT03 True Brown Antiquing, SP03 Gloss-It, SP07 Krackle-It, SP08 Matte Spray

Step 1: Basecoat base Black. Apply Krackle-It and let dry. Using a soft fan brush paint on Toast being careful not to overlap. Float Real Brown and Leather Brown around rings at sides.

Step 2: Basecoat lion's heads Toast and bark areas Black. Webbrush wood with Real Brown, then Toast, then Sand, then Cream. Tint wood with still in your brush, add Country Blue and highlight bark. Tint wood with Leather Brown wash.

Step 3: Webbrush lion with Mustard. Highlight with Flaxon Yellow. Highlight hair and above eyes and muzzle with Cream. Tint hair and face with Toast. Paint eyes Mustard, shade with Cream. Paint pupils Black with White highlights. Paint nose Leather Brown, lighten with Cream and highlight nose. Paint lips and around eyes with Black. Shade around eyes, light nose, inside ears and bark with Black.

Step 4: Antique with True Brown translucent. Wipe away to lighten more with cloth dampened with solvent. Spray with Matte Spray. Paint eyes with Gless-It.

DH2551 Dragon Tart Burner (3 per mold, 5.5") and DH2558 Base (1" x 6.5")

Materials and Colors: clear glaze, fired-on gold, DH08 Black, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH31 Leaf Green, SP07 Krackle-It
Step 1: Apply two coats of clear glaze to areas you want gold. Fire and then apply fired-on gold and re-fire. Basecoat base with Midnight Blue. Apply Krackle-It and let dry. With soft fan brush and without overlapping, paint on Leaf Green.
Step 2: Basecoat remaining areas of dragons Black. Webbrush with Midnight Blue, then Mystic Purple on face and area with scales. Webbrush Leaf Green on nose, sides along belly and mane. Float Midnight Blue along green areas and mane. Float Leaf Green under eyes on cheeks.
Step 3: Paint eyes and teeth Bone. Shade with Toast. Paint Black V on eyes and thin line along upper edge. Highlight with White dot.

DH2537 Wild Horse Frame (4" x 6")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH26 Lexington Green, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

Step 1: Webbrush entire piece with Real Brown. With color still in your brush, add Toast and webbrush lower left horse and upper right horse. With color still in your brush, add Mustard and webbrush highlights on horses bodies. With color still in your brush, add Flaxon Yellow and lightly highlight bodies again. Heavily webbrush manes and tails with Flaxon Yellow. Highlight with Cream. Shade crevices of bodies and along manes with a Toast wash.

Step 2: Webbrush remaining two horses with Leather Brown. Highlight lightly with Toast. Paint manes and tails Black. Paint Cream markings on each horse's face as desired. Paint eyes Real Brown with Black pupils.
Step 3: Webbrush rocks Light Grey. Shade and tint the rocks with washes of Toast and Country Blue. Highlight rocks with Cream. Webbrush all remaining background with Grass Green. With color still in your brush, add Mustard and webbrush background again. With color still in your brush, add Toast and lightly webbrush ground areas. Webbrush trees with Lexington Green. With color still in your brush, add Country Blue and lightly webbrush trees again.
Step 4: Corner load a 1/2" shader with Black and shade frame as necessary to define detail. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2483 Large Driftwood Lion (18" x 12") & DH2519 Large Lion Wall Hanging (12" x 8")

Materials and Colors: DH08 Black, DH10 Mustard, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH21 Sand, DH25 Toast, DH29 White, DH34 Soft Brown, AT04 Red Brown antiquing, SP08 Matte Spray, soft cloth, solvent
Step 1: Basecoat lion with Flaxon Yellow, Basecoat wood with Black. Antique lion with Red Brown antiquing translucent and wipe off with a soft cloth. Use solvent on the rag to wipe back antiquing.
Step 2: Webbrush Flaxon Yellow on lion's face and Toast on mane. Corner load brush and shade Toast around face, nose, ears and eyes. Webbrush White around muzzle and eyes. Paint eyes Mustard. Paint nose Leather Brown. Shade around the eyes and nose areas with a Leather Brown wash.
Step 3: Lightly webbrush highlights on the fur with Mustard then add Soft Brown to highlight areas further. Add washes of Sand, Toast and Leather Brown to highlight areas further. Add washes of Sand, Toast and Leather

Brown to wood. Shade recessed areas with a Black wash. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH1756 Sports Frame (5" x 7")

Materials and Colors: DH01 Daifodil, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH25 Toast, DH29 White, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, DH45 Shadow Green, SP08 Matte Spray, AT01 Black antiquing translucent
Step 1: Basecoat piece with Cream. Add washes of Grass Green, Daifodil and shade with Shadow Green on grass areas. Paint Leather Brown on baseball gloves and baseball White. Paint basketball Toast and football with Real Brown. Paint soccer ball White.
Step 2: Antique piece with Black antiquing translucent and wipe off with a soft cloth. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2536 Butterfly Frame (4" x 6")

Materials and Colors: DH01 Daifodil, DH05 Purple, DH14 Rose, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH31 Leaf Green, DH40 Turquoise, DH45 Shadow Green, DH52 Cranberry, SP08 Matte Spray sealer
Step 1: Basecoat frame with Midnight Blue. Webbrush flowers with Mystic Purple and highlight with Purple. Paint large flowers with Rose and highlight all flowers with White. Shade with Cranberry. Add Daifodil in center of all flowers.
Step 2: Basecoat butterflies Turquoise and shade with Midnight Blue. Outline wings with Black. Basecoat leaves with Leaf Green and shade with Shadow Green.
Step 3: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2530 Butterfly Plaque (12" x 12")

Materials and Colors: DH01 Daifodil, DH03 True Orange, DH08 Black, DH22 Christmas Red, DH25 Toast, DH31 Leaf Green, DH37 Cream, DH40 Turquoise, DH45 Shadow Green, DH52 Cranberry, SP08 Matte Spray sealer
Step 1: Basecoat plaque with Toast and webbrush Cream. Paint flowers with Christmas Red and shade with Cranberry.
Step 2: Paint leaves with Leaf Green and highlight with Daifodil. Shade with Shadow Green.
Step 3: Paint first butterfly with Turquoise, second butterfly with True Orange, third butterfly with Daifodil. Paint veins with Black. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2471 Santa with Globes (11" x 9")

Materials and Colors: DH03 True Orange, DH04 True Red, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH19 Light Grey, DH22 Christmas Red, DH24 Terra Cotta, DH25 Toast, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, AT04 Red Brown Translucent, SP08 Matte Spray, SP14 Antique-It, clear glaze, liquid fired-on gold
Step 1: Apply clear glaze to areas for fired-on gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply liquid gold and fire to cone 018.
Step 2: Basecoat piece with Soft Brown. Basecoat beard with Light Grey. Paint Christmas Red on suit and hat. Highlight with True Orange and shade with Cranberry. Add a wash of Flaxon Yellow to shirt and globe. Apply a wash of Grass Green and Flaxon Yellow mix to land areas on globe. Corner load brush and shade globe with Toast.
Step 3: Antique Santa's face and hands and globe with Red Brown antiquing. Wipe off with a soft cloth. Webbrush beard and fur with White. Webbrush scroll Cream and highlight with White.

Step 4: Basecoat stand with Terra Cotta, highlight with Toast, Flaxon Yellow and Cream. Shade with Real Brown. Paint packages with Grass Green, White and True Red. Apply a wash of Leather Brown, Toast, Country Blue and Real Brown to wood. Shade with Black. Paint boots Black.
Step 5: Paint eyes Country Blue and lips True Red. Chalk cheeks. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.
