TECHNIQUE SHEET 135

DH 1312, 1313, 1314, 1315 & 1316
CHILDREN, MOSES - GREEN ROBE, JESUS &
ANIMALS, MARY/DONKEY & JOSEPH

hair with Sandalwood; shade it with Red Brown Wash.

Step 8: Basecoat all remaining areas on pieces with Black.

Step 9: Drybrush all rock areas with Soft Grey. Use washes of

Sandalwood, Heather Blue, Red Brown, Black and Blue Green Mist to shade the rocks. Drybrush the rocks with Buttermilk to blend and highlight the colors. Drybrush all grass and leaf areas with Sap Green. Use Artichoke, Inca Gold and Sandalwood to drybrush highlights on these areas.

Deer: Drybrush with Red Brown, then Henna. Drybrush highlights on the fur with Sandalwood. Drybrush the "White" areas on deer with Buttermilk. Shade around ears and crevices around muscles with a Black wash. Paint his nose Black. **Donkey:** Drybrush fur same as for deer. Drybrush Buttermilk on muzzle, inside ears and around eyes. Shade around muzzle and ears and recessed areas with a Balck wash. Paint the bridle Henna.

Step 10: Paint all eyes (except blonde children's) with Sable Brown Iris'. Black pupils and lashes. Paint blonde children's eyes with Heather Blue Iris'. Brush cheeks with chalk.

Step 11: Spray with Matte Sealer; spray again with Porcelain Sealer.

DH 1313 NOSES WITH RED ROBE

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Tools, Soft Cloth, Chalk, True Matte Sealer.

Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Hummelized Flesh, Black, White, Soft, Gray, Garnet, Red, Warm Beige, Folk-Art Blue, Butter Milk, Red Brown, Sable Brown, Black Translucent Stain, Hummelized Flesh Translucent Stain.

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 06.

Step 2: Basecoat flesh with Hummelized Flesh. Gown with Warm Beige. Robe with Garnett Red. Belt with Folk-Art Blue.

Step 3: Antique skin with Hummelized Flesh. Antique gown, robe and tablets with Black.

Step 4: Paint hair Black. Drybrush Gray and with paint still in the brush, highlight with Soft Gray.

Step 5: Drybrush robe with Red. Tablets with Buttermilk.

Step 6: Paint eyes with Red Brown and shade with Sable Brown. With Sno-White apply a tiny dot to each eye to highlight.

Step 7: Chalk Cheeks and lips with Russet.

Step 8: Spray piece with True Matte Sealer.

DH 1311 MADONNA & CHILD

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Tools, Soft Cloth, Chalk, True Matte Sealer.

Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Sno-White, Black, Soft Pink, Sky

Blue, Uniform Blue, Gray, Buttermilk, Sandalwood, Oriental Flesh, Hummelized Flesh, Glistening Gray, Translucent Stain and Hummelized Flesh, Translucent Stain.

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 06.

Step 2: Basecoat flesh with Hummelized Flesh. Basecoat robe with Uniform Blue. Basecoat gown in White.

Step 3: Paint hair on Mary Sandalwood, hair on baby Oriental Flesh. Paint rock with Black.

Step 4: Antique hair and flesh with Glistening Gray Translucent Stain.

Step 5: Drybrush gown and part of robe White. Drybrush uniform Blue on robe and highlight softly with White.

Step 6: Shade Soft Pink on White gown and White hood. Also use a little Sky Blue.

Step 7: Drybrush Gray on rocks and shade Soft Pink and Blue on rocks. Drybrush Buttermilk on top of colors. Shade Black on rock to separate dress from rocks.

Step 8: Paint Black for pupils and use Sandalwood for irises'.

Chalk lips and cheeks with Peach.

Step 9: Spray with True Matte Sealer.
