

OLD WORLD SANTAS

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Cleaning Tools, Airbrush, Snow-It, Fingertip Gold, Ultra Fine Glitter, Clear Nail Polish, Clear Gloss Glaze, Liquid Gold, Chalk for Blushing Skin.

Colors by Doc Holliday: Black, Red Brown, White, Terra Cotta, Christmas Red, Flesh, Light Grey, Cream, Gold, Lexington Green, Country Blue, Real Brown, Dark Grey, Toast, True Red, Mustard, Flaxen Yellow, Navy Blue, Medium Brown, Beige, Gold Metallic, Matte Spray, Antiquing Translucents, Black, Red Brown, Black Brown, Ceramichromes Sparkling Sandstone #C5521 Gold Stone.

DH 1387 – SCOTTISH SANTA

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Apply 2 coats Clear Glaze to areas to be Gold. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 3: Apply Liquid Gold to glazed areas. Fire to Cone 019.
Step 4: After piece is completed, paint snow areas White. Then apply Snow-It to these areas. While still wet, sprinkle with Ultra-Fine Glitter.
Step 5: Airbrush horse with Toast. Airbrush lower legs and blaze Cream. Antique entire horse with Black Brown Translucent. Wipe off excess stain with a soft cloth dampened with solvent. Basecoat face Flesh, beard and hair Light Grey. Antique these areas with Red Brown.
Step 6: Basecoat all remaining areas, except snow, with Black. Drybrush mane and tail with Flaxen Yellow; highlight edges of mane and tail and lower legs with cream.
Step 7: Drybrush bridle, trim on wreath, bow, cape, kilt, socks and hat Christmas Red. Drybrush saddle blanket, bagpipe bag, wreath Lexington Green. Highlight wreath by drybrushing with Lexington Green mixed with White. Paint saddle Real Brown. Drybrush fringe on saddle blanket, beard and hair White. Paint pom-pom on hat White.
Step 8: Paint plaid pattern on cape, kilt and socks and bagpipe bag using Black, Lexington Green, Christmas Red and White. Paint a Red and White stripe on lower edge of saddle blanket. Paint wide White stripes on hatband and headband on bridle. Shade all recessed areas and fabric folds with a Black Wash. Apply Snow-It to pom-pom on hat. Paint bagpipes with clear nail polish to give them gloss.
Step 9: Paint horse's eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Paint Santa's eyes with Country Blue iris' and Black pupils. Blush cheeks with chalk.

DH 1389 – AFRICAN SANTA

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Apply 2 coats Clear Glaze to areas to be Gold. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 3: Apply Liquid Gold to glazed areas. Fire to Cone 019.
Step 4: Basecoat mule Cream. Antique mule with Red Brown Translucent stain. Wipe off excess stain with a soft cloth.
Step 5: Drybrush mule with Cream. Lightly drybrush again with White (heavily on tail and mane). Shade base of mane, hooves, around bridle areas with Medium Brown Wash. Paint eyes with Medium Brown iris', Black pupils.
Step 6: Basecoat all remaining areas, except ground, with Black. Drybrush skin with Real Brown. Drybrush dress with Christmas Red. Add a little White to brush and drybrush lighter red highlights to folds of dress. Paint handle of feathers and ridged base of feathers, and harness on mule's chest and hips Christmas Red. Repaint Black stripes on harness.
Step 7: Drybrush robe, tassels, bridle and hat Lexington Green. Highlight edges of tassels with Lexington Green lightened with White. Drybrush fringe on bridle, beard and feathers White. Shade feathers with a wash of Christmas Red. Shade all recessed areas of clothing and tassels with a Black Wash. Paint White stripes on raised lower edge of dress and sleeves. Paint Gold on edges of sleeves and dress.
Step 8: Rub on Finger-Tip Gold to robe and hat. Finish the ground as described for Mexican Santa.

DH 1386 – MEXICAN SANTA

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Basecoat face and hands with Flesh. Antique with Premiers Red Brown Antiquing and wipe with soft cloth.
Step 3: Except for base, basecoat rest of piece with Black.
Step 4: Drybrush toy bag with Dark Grey, touch up Black if needed.
Step 5: Paint bear inside of toy bag with Toast. Paint doll's face and leg with Flesh. Paint bear with Country Blue. Add some Navy Blue stripes down front of dress. Paint a White collar on dress. Hair is done with Mustard. Paint some

eyes and lips on doll. Drybrush leaves around front and back of bag with Lexington Green. Lighten with a little White and highlight.
Step 6: Drybrush burrow and staff with Real Brown and drybrush Toast over burrow again with Medium Brown on staff. Drybrush muzzle, around eyes and inside ears with Cream. Paint hooves Medium Brown.

Step 7: Drybrush Santa's beard and shirt with 2 or 3 coats of White.
Step 8: Paint burro's harness, bow and straps around toy bag with True Red. Drybrush top half of vest and his pants and hat with True Red. Without rinsing your brush, add a little Cream and highlight the folds on vest and pants.
Step 9: Drybrush bottom half of vest with Lexington Green. Lighten with Cream and highlight.

Step 10: Drybrush rocks with Light Grey. Make a wash using Toast and apply randomly to rocks. Highlight rocks using Cream.

Step 11: Paint boots Black. Using a 1/2" shader brush, corner load and shade around sleeves, harness, bag and rocks with Black.

Step 12: Santa's eyes are Country Blue with Black pupils. Burro's eyes are Medium Brown with Black pupils.

Step 13: Using the premiers Finger-Tip Gold, rub on Santa's hat. Paint a couple of stripes on vest and burro's saddle with premiers Gold Metallic and also tassels on boots. Apply a Leather Brown Wash to lips.

Step 14: Paint base with Beige and use Ceramichrome Sparkling Sandstone #C5521 Gold Stone to give base the look of sand. Spray with Matte Spray if desired.

DH 1388 – GERMAN SANTA

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Apply 2 coats Clear Glaze to areas to be Gold. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 3: Apply Liquid Gold to glazed areas. Fire to Cone 019.
Step 4: After piece is completed, paint snow areas White. Then apply Snow-It to these areas. While still wet, sprinkle with Ultra-Fine Glitter.
Step 5: Airbrush horse with Terra Cotta. Airbrush mane, tail, muzzle and lower legs Black. Clean paint off Gold areas with a damp paper towel.
Step 6: Antique horse with Black Translucent. Wipe off excess stain with a soft cloth, dampened with solvent.
Step 7: Basecoat face with Flesh, beard and hair with Light Grey; fur trim on coat with Cream. Antique these areas with Red Brown Translucent.
Step 8: Basecoat all remaining areas, except snow, Black.
Step 9: Drybrush coat, hat, gloves and bow with Christmas Red. Rub Fingertip Gold on coat and stein.
Step 10: Drybrush Lexington Green on trees, bridle, breastband and saddle blanket. Add a little White to your brush and drybrush highlights on the trees.
Step 11: Drybrush fur, rope trim on saddle blanket, beard and feather White. Shade base of feather with a Christmas Red Wash. Paint tiny white dots on bridle and breastband for decoration. Paint necklace with Gold circles and Red centers. Carefully outline Gold areas with a fine line of Black. Paint horse's eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Paint Santa's eyes with Country Blue iris' and Black pupils. Blush cheeks and lips with chalk. Apply Snow-It thickly on stain for bear froth.


DH 1390 – ITALIAN SANTA

Step 1: Clean greenware. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Apply 2 coats Clear Glaze to areas to be Gold. Fire to Cone 03.
Step 3: Apply Liquid Gold to glazed areas. Fire to cone 019.
Step 4: After piece is completed, paint snow areas White. Then apply Snow-It to these areas. While still wet, sprinkle with Ultra-Fine Glitter.
Step 5: Airbrush horse Light Grey (darkened slightly with a few drops of Black). Open airbrush to full spray, hold at arms length and spray White on horse to create a speckled grey color. Airbrush mane, tail, muzzle, hooves, hocks and knees with Dark Grey. Antique horse with Black Translucent. Wipe off excess stain with a cloth dampened with solvent.
Step 6: Basecoat Santa's skin with Flesh; his beard and hair with Light Grey. Antique with Red Brown Translucent. Basecoat all remaining areas, except snow, Black.
Step 7: Paint saddle blanket Christmas Red. Stipple center section with White. Drybrush bow, cinch cloth on horse's chest, bridle, Santa's hat and robe with Christmas Red. Highlight by adding a little White to your brush and drybrushing the folds and edges.
Step 8: Drybrush the top robe, sashes and holly leaves Lexington Green. Drybrush highlights to edges of holly by adding White to your brush. Paint criss-cross pattern on saddle blanket Black. Drybrush saddle Real Brown;

highlight edges with Medium Brown. Paint holly berries Christmas Red.
Step 9: Drybrush beard and hair White. Paint White trim on robe, sash and armbands of robe. Paint criss-cross pattern on saddle blanket Lexington Green, leaving a little Black showing on the sides of each line for shading.
Step 10: Shade around blanket and saddle with a Black Wash. Carefully line around Gold areas with Black.
Step 11: Drybrush mane and tail Light Grey. Rub on Finger-Tip Gold to Santa's robe.
Step 12: Paint horse's eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Paint Santa's eyes with Country Blue iris' and Black pupils.

BASE – DH 1351

Step 1: Basecoat all, except top, Black.
Step 2: Drybrush all the leaves Sap Green. Drybrush the edges of each leaf with Teal Green. Lighten the Teal Green with a little White and highlight the edges again. Shade the center of each leaf first with a Prussian Blue wash, then a Black wash. Shade around each leaf with a Black wash.
Step 3: Paint the top White. Paint the nameplate Venetian Gold. Paint the berries Persian Red. Paint desired country's name on nameplate with Black.
Step 4: Spray with Matt Spray.
Step 5: Apply an even, thin coat of White glue to top of base. While still wet, sprinkle with Ultra-Fine Glitter.



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
