

INCENSE SMOKERS – DH 1446 Base, DH 1447 Dragon, DH 1448 Knight

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Glaze, Incense Sticks.

Colors By Doc Holliday: DH-8 Black, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-29 White, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-43 Teal, DH-3 True Orange, DH-31 Leaf Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-48 Gold, FT-1 Finger Tip Silver.

Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to cone 03. Apply Black Glaze to long incense base and fire to Cone 05.

Step 2: Basecoat entire pieces with Black. Drybrush bases and castle with Light Grey. Apply washes of Mystic Purple and Teal to these areas and highlight with White.

Step 3: Drybrush dragons with Real Brown and again with Christmas Red. Drybrush belly and under side of tail with True Orange. Highlight body of dragon with Mustard.

Step 4: Drybrush the following areas with Mystic Purple: dragon wings, ridge of back, around face and knight's cape. Knight's head feathers are drybrushed with Christmas Red.

Step 5: Apply Fingertip Silver to Knight's armor and sword. Paint dragon's teeth White and eyes are Leaf Green with Black pupils. Castle roofs and trim on armor are Gold. Shade all areas with a Black wash.

DH 1444 WIZARD SMOKER

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray.

Colors By Doc Holliday: DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-25 Toast, DH-37 Cream, DH-21 Sand, DH-Grass Green, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-3 True Orange, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-5 Purple, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-48 Gold, DH-47 Silver.

Step 1: Basecoat skin Sand. Apply a thin wash of Toast over areas to antique.

Step 2: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

Step 3: Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Randomly apply washes of True Orange, Purple and Black to shade the rocks. Drybrush Cream on edges of rocks for highlights.

Step 4: Drybrush wizard's clothes Christmas Red. Add increasing amounts of True Orange to your brush and drybrush highlights on clothing folds. Add a small amount of White to same brush and drybrush additional highlights on clothing. Drybrush beard Light Grey; highlight with White. Paint book pages; darken with a Toast wash. Paint book covers Grass Green and Leather Brown. Paint sword, goblet rim and bottom, and treasure chest Silver. Paint cape lining, crown, belt, etc. Gold. Shade clothing folds with a Black wash. Paint eyes with Grass Green irises and Black pupils.

Step 5: Spray with Matte Spray.

GLAZED DRAGONS & CASTLE

DH 1443, 1445, 1367, 1188, 1417, 1427

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Air Gun, Sponge.

Opaque Underglazes by Ceramichrome: (116) Turquoise, (92) Light Grey, (111) Marine Blue, (106) Grape, (105) Orchid, (78) Folk-Art-Blue, (133) Black, Fired on Gold.

One Strokes: D-4 Pumpkin Yellow, D-23 Black, D-34 Light Flesh.

Step 1: Clean greenware.

Step 2: Put greenware on turn-table, mix underglaze with water (1/2 & 1/2). Use air-gun, start with lighter colors and work your way to darker colors.

Step 3: Spray pieces with (105) Orchid all over. Use darker colors to highlight – (106) Grape and (111) Marine Blue.

Step 4: Use (78) Folk-Art-Blue in all the shaded areas.

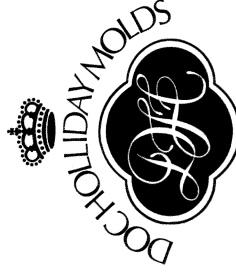
Step 5: Paint eyes, teeth and nails with One-Strokes D-4 Pumpkin Yellow, D-23 Black, and D-34 Light Flesh.

Step 6: Fire to Cone 04.

Step 7: Antique your piece with (78) Folk-Art-Blue. Thin color with water, put over entire pieces and wipe off with sponge, leaving some in crevices.

Step 8: Put 2 coats of Clear Glaze on pieces and fire to Cone 06.

Step 9: Apply Fire on Gold wherever you want.
