

# "NEW ILLUMINATIONS"

## TECHNIQUE SHEET 176

### PK-110 CANDLE STICK HOLDER

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Old Worm Brush, Fan Brush, Black Glaze, Non-Fired Sparkling Sand Stones #CS510, Grey Purples by Ceramichrome.

- Step 1:** Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 03.
- Step 2:** Apply Black Glaze to top, bottom and center band around candle holder and fire to Cone 05.
- Step 3:** Using an old worm brush, apply two to three coats of Grey Purples to center smooth areas of candle holder. NOTE: Be sure to cross hatch the Grey Purples.

### INCENSE SMOKERS DH-1446 BASE, DH-1447 DRAGON, DH-1448 KNIGHT

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Glaze, Incense Slicks.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 Light Grey, DH-29 White, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-43 Teal, DH-3 True Orange, DH-31 Leaf Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-48 Gold, FT-1 Finger Tip Silver.

- Step 1:** Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 03. Apply Black Glaze to long incense base and fire to Cone 05.
- Step 2:** Basecoat entire pieces with Black. Drybrush bases and castle and highlight with White.
- Step 3:** Drybrush dragons with Real Brown and again with Christmas Red. Drybrush belly and under side of tail with True Orange. Highlight body of dragon with Mustard.
- Step 4:** Drybrush the following areas with Mystic Purple: dragon wings, ridge of back, around face and knight's caps. Knight's head feathers are drybrushed with Christmas Red.
- Step 5:** Apply Fingertip Silver to knight's armor and sword. Paint dragon's teeth White and eyes are Leaf Green with Black pupils. Castle roofs and trim on armor are Gold. Shade all areas with a Black wash.

### KALEIDOSCOPIES - DH-965, DH-967, DH-968 & DH-969

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Clear Glaze, Liquid Bright Gold, Rhinestones, Purple Brush-On Glitter, Kaleidoscope Kit.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-43 Teal, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-6 Lavender, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-27 Midnight Blue, FT-2 Finger-Tip Gold, SP-1 Texture-It, SP-3 Glass-It, DH-49 Premier Gold.

- Step 1:** Clean greenware and fire to Cone 03. Apply 2 coats of Clear Glaze to bands of kaleidoscope and fire to Cone 05. Apply Liquid Bright Gold to bands and fire to Cone 018.
- Step 2:** Apply Purple. Basecoat smooth areas with Teal. Basecoat leg area with Regal Purple. Basecoat leeches with Mystic Purple and then Lavender. Brush Glass-It on Teal area, after shading around faces with Midnight Blue. Apply Purple.
- Step 3:** Dry Glass Kaleidoscope - Basecoat smooth areas with Black. Add Texture-It to Black stain and spread evenly over smooth areas using a stiff brush. Drybrush with Midnight Blue. Drybrush again with the following colors, letting each color fade into the other: Regal Purple, Mystic Purple and then with Lavender. Paint random stars on kaleidoscope and then give a rhinestone in center of stars.
- Step 4:** Basecoat kaleidoscope holders with Black. Rub Gold Finger-Tip over entire piece.

### NOAH'S ARK SILHOUETTE - DH-1703 BASE, DH-1708 NOAH'S ARK, BACKGROUND, DH-1709 NOAH'S ARK

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Gold Dust Brush-On Glitter, Matte Spray Sealer.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-10 Mustard, DH-12 Leaf Green, DH-25 Teal, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-14 Rose, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-25 Leaf Green, DH-37 Cream, DH-35 Powder Blue, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-5 Purple, DH-4 True Blue, DH-1 Daffodil, DH-3 True Orange, DH-39 Premier Gold, DH-20 Sky Blue, DH-32 Christmas Green, DH-49 Premier Gold.

- Step 1:** Basecoat sky Powder Blue. Basecoat ark Real Brown. Basecoat rainbow White. Basecoat rocks Country Blue. Basecoat roof of ark Mustard.
- Step 2:** Wet-brush rocks with Cream. Shade and tint them with washes of Rose and Country Blue. Tint the path with a Rose wash. Wet-brush back over rocks with Cream to highlight.
- Step 3:** Wet-brush the following areas with Mystic Purple and Regal Purple. Highlight trim with Country Blue. Paint White on their tops. Shade them first with Regal Purple, then with Midnight Blue wash.
- Step 4:** Basecoat all remaining parts of scene and front Black.
- Step 5:** Wet-brush the water with Midnight Blue. Add increasing amounts of White to same brush and highlight water. Tint water lightly

**Step 4:** Paint ostrich's, elephant's rhino's and kangaroo's Light Grey. Shade them with a Black wash. Tint ostrich's necks and legs with a Rose wash. Paint horns White. Paint antelope Real Brown; highlight with Teal. Paint markings with White; paint antlers Black. Paint zebras White. Paint stripes, mane, tail and muzzles Black. Paint giraffes and lions Flaxon Yellow. Shade them with a wash of Teal. Paint giraffes and spots and manes with Teal; highlight muzzles and inside giraffe's and lion's ears with Cream. Paint lions noses Leather Brown. Shade male lion's mane lightly with a Black wash.

- Step 5:** Paint rainbow with washes of Purple, Bright Blue, Sky Blue, Christmas Green, Daffodil, True Orange and True Red in that order. Paint lines between colors Premier Gold.
- Step 6:** Paint all remaining areas of pieces Country Blue.
- Step 7:** Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Glue front to back. Insert snap-in light.
- Step 8:** Apply Gold Dust Brush-On Glitter to gold bands in rainbow.

### DUCK SILHOUETTE - DH-1703 BASE, DH-1706 DUCK, BACKGROUND, DH-1707 MARSH FOREGROUND

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Snap-In Light, Matte Spray Sealer.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-25 Teal, DH-12 Leaf Green, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-35 Navy Blue, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-10 Mustard, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-1 Daffodil, DH-37 Cream, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-24 Terra Cotta.

- Step 1:** Basecoat sky Flaxon Yellow. Tint sky with washes of Mustard and Terra Cotta. Keeping the color darkest near the horizon. Block-in clouds with Terra Cotta. Float a wash of White on edges of clouds. Shade darker areas of clouds with washes of Terra Cotta and Leaf Green. Highlight clouds lightly with a thin wash of Mustard.
- Step 2:** Basecoat all remaining detail areas of back and entire front piece with Black.
- Step 3:** Wet-brush the ducks with Real Brown. Highlight with Medium Brown. Wet-brush lower body of males with White. Paint upper chest Leather Brown; feet and beaks Mustard; heads Shadow Green lightened with White. Shade beaks and feet and lower body with a wash of Teal. Paint White neck rings on males. Paint blue section of wings Country Blue, lined with a Midnight Blue wash; highlight edge of blue with White. Shade ducks' feathers with a Black wash. Paint eyes Black.
- Step 4:** Wet-brush water with Midnight Blue lightened with a little White. Add more White and highlight water. Lightly tint water with a wash of Mystic Purple. Paint background mountains Shadow Green, lightened with a little Cream.
- Step 5:** Wet-brush all remaining areas of front with Real Brown. Wet brush grasses and tree leaves with Grass Green; add Mustard to same brush and wet-brush highlights on these areas. Repeat highlights to adding Cream to same brush. Tint some of the grasses with a wash of Teal.
- Step 6:** Wet-brush trees and cattails with Medium Brown; highlight by adding Cream to same brush. Paint individual leaves Mustard; shade and highlight them with washes of Shadow Green and Cream. Wet-brush heron with Country Blue. Shade feathers with a Navy Blue wash. Paint markings with Black and White. Paint beak and eye Mustard. Shade Country Blue. Paint patch on shoulder with Black lightened slightly with White. Paint lower bird's body White; shade with Teal. Highlight upper body with Teal. Paint Black and White markings on bird. Shade front piece with a Black wash and line where necessary with Black to define detail.
- Step 7:** Apply 1 coat Crackle-It to frame of front. Let dry. Apply 1 heavy coat Leather Brown over Crackle-It. Let dry.
- Step 8:** Paint inside walls of back with Terra Cotta. Paint remaining areas of back Black.
- Step 9:** Spray both pieces with Matte Spray Sealer, then glue together. Insert Snap-In Light.

### DEER SILHOUETTE - DH-1705 BASE, DH-1704 DEER, BACKGROUND & DH-1705 TREE FOREGROUND

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Snap-In Light, Matte Spray Sealer.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** SP-7 Crackle-It, DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-12 Leaf Green, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-35 Powder Blue, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-10 Mustard, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-25 Teal, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-26 Lexington Green, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-37 Cream, DH-21 Sand.

- Step 1:** Basecoat sky Powder Blue. Tint sky with washes of Mystic Purple and Country Blue. Block-in clouds with a heavy White wash. Tint and shade clouds with washes of Mystic Purple and Regal Purple. Highlight clouds with more White. Paint in mountains with Country Blue. Highlight trim with Country Blue. Paint White on their tops. Shade them first with Regal Purple, then with Midnight Blue wash.
- Step 2:** Basecoat all remaining parts of scene and front Black.
- Step 3:** Wet-brush the water with Midnight Blue. Add increasing amounts of White to same brush and highlight water. Tint water lightly

with Mystic Purple.

**Step 4:** Wet-brush all remaining Black areas with Real Brown. Add Teal to same brush and wet-brush trees. Highlight them with washes of Teal. Wet-brush rocks Light Grey. Shade them with washes of Teal, Leaf Green and Country Blue. Highlight them with Cream.

**Step 5:** Wet-brush trees and ground with Grass Green. Lighten ground areas with Mustard and Teal added to same brush. Wet-brush creek bank with washes of Real Brown and Teal. Wet-brush evergreens with Lexington Green. Add Country Blue to same brush and highlight limbs and separate background trees. Add a little Cream to same brush and highlight further. Shade trees and grass areas with a Shadow Green wash.

**Step 6:** Wet-brush deer with Teal. Paint White markings on deer. Shade them with a Black wash. Highlight antlers with Medium Brown them Cream. Shade all areas of the piece with Black to define and accent detail.

- Step 7:** Paint around back insert with Country Blue. Paint remaining areas of back Black.
- Step 8:** Apply 1 coat Crackle-It to frame of front. Let dry. Apply 1 heavy coat Leather Brown over Crackle-It. Touch up Black as needed.
- Step 9:** Spray entire piece with Matte Spray Sealer.
- Step 10:** Glue front to back and insert Snap-In Light.

### FLION (WINGED LION) - DH-1717

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Peach Brush-On Glitter, Matte Spray Sealer.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-10 Mustard, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-25 Teal, DH-12 Leaf Green, Brown, AT-2 Black Brown Translucent.

- Step 1:** Basecoat lion Mustard. Antique with Black Brown Translucent.
- Step 2:** Wet-brush lion with Mustard. Lighten around feet, face and ears by adding Cream to same brush. Wet-brush mane and tail with Teal.
- Step 3:** Add Mustard to same brush and use to highlight mane and tail; repeat highlighting by adding a little Cream.
- Step 4:** Shade lion with washes of Teal, Real Brown and Black, in that order. Paint nose Leather Brown. Paint eyes Mustard. Paint lips, around eyes, pupils and shade nose with Black.
- Step 5:** Basecoat wings Cream. Shade between feather sections with a Teal wash. Shade wings closest to body with a Real Brown wash. Tint ends of feathers with a wash of Flaxon Yellow. Lightly wet-brush near the ends of wings with Cream to blend in the yellow.
- Step 6:** Apply Peach Brush-On Glitter to wings, avoiding feather ends.
- Step 7:** Apply Peach Brush-On Glitter to guardians.

### BAT CAT SMOKER - DH-1723 & GUARDIAN SMOKER - DH-1724 & SMOKER BASE - DH-1364

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Clear Glaze, Liquid Bright Gold, Fired-On Silver, Black Glaze, Incense Cone, Stiff Brushes, Small Fan Brush.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-47 Silver, DH-52 Cranberry, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-42 Dark Grey, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-29 White, DH-10 Mustard, SP-1 Texture-It, SP-7 Crackle-It.

- Step 1:** Clean greenware is still wet, cut opening in the mouth of each smoker and drain. Apply Clear Glaze to chain around lions neck, edge of shield on Bat Cat and bottom rims of each base. Apply Black Glaze to top of bases and the two plain squares of shield. Fire to cone 05. Apply Liquid Gold to chain and bottom rim of Lion base. Apply Silver to edge of shield and bottom rim of Bat Cat base. Fire to cone 018.
- Step 2:** Basecoat smokers and bases with Black. Mix Black with Texture-It and use a stiff brush and apply to each piece. Spread the Texture-It around as much as possible.
- Step 3:** Brush on Crackle-It to wings and bottom of each smoker and bases. Let dry for 1 hour. Load a small fan brush with Dark Grey and apply to these areas following instructions on bottle.
- Step 4:** Drybrush bodies of smokers with Dark Grey. Highlight faces, tails, mane of lion and bases heavily with Light Grey and then White.
- Step 5:** Paint noses Black, teeth White and eyes Mustard with Black pupils. Paint unglazed squares of shield with Cranberry and then dry-brush with Christmas Red. Paint emblem on squares with Silver.
- Step 6:** Corner load a 1/2" shader brush with Black and shade each piece.

### DRAGON SILHOUETTE - DH-1703 BASE, DH-1727 DRAGON, BACKGROUND, DH-1728 DRAGON FOREGROUND

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Gold & Purple Glitter, Doc's Glue, Snap-In Light, Matte Spray Sealer.

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-1 Daffodil, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-3 True Orange, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-49 Premier Gold, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-21 Sand, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-37 Cream, DH-9

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Real Brown, DH-25 Teal, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-26 Lexington Green.

**Step 1:** Basecoat sky Flaxon Yellow. Tint upper part of sky with a wash of Terra Cotta. Tint lower part of sky with wash of Mystic Purple.

**Step 2:** Basecoat all remaining detail areas with Black.

**Step 3:** Wet-brush dragon's belly with White. Wet-brush Daffodil over the White. Shade sides of belly, first with a true Orange wash, then a Christmas Red wash.

**Step 4:** Wet-brush all rocks, hills, small castle and bricks with Light Grey. Tint the rocky parts of castle, the rocks and the hills with washes of True Orange, Mystic Purple, Regal Purple and Midnight Blue. Shade the small castle lightly with a wash of Mystic Purple. Highlight these areas by wet-brushing with Cream. Tint the brick areas of castle with a wash of Sand. Highlight around the windows and doors with Cream. Paint the doors, around the arched windows and the horizontal trim on roofs Premier Gold. Shade the arches and sides of castle walls with a Black wash. Line where necessary to define detail.

**Step 5:** Wet-brush the trees with Real Brown. Add Teal to same brush and wet-brush again; repeat with Sand, then Country Blue. Wet-brush evergreens textured leaves with Grass Green. Add Mustard to same brush and wet-brush leaves again; lighten the edges with more Mustard. Add a little Teal to same brush and tint some areas of the leaves. Wet-brush the evergreens with Lexington Green; add Country Blue to same brush and highlight trees. Add a little Cream to same brush and highlight further. Shade under branches of all trees with a Shadow Green wash. Paint separate vein in each leaf. Line around leaves and branches as needed to define detail. Shade trees with a Black wash.

**Step 6:** Wet-brush dragon with Grass Green. Add Mustard, then Daffodil and wet-brush highlights on dragon. Shade muscles and indentations on dragon with a Shadow Green wash, then a Black wash. Highlight around face with Daffodil, True Orange and White. Paint mouth and eye Christmas Red. Paint his Daffodil with Black all pupils. Paint toenails and horn on nose Premier Gold.

- Step 7:** Paint walls around dragon insert Mystic Purple. Paint remaining areas Black.
- Step 8:** Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.
- Step 9:** Apply Finger-Tip Gold to textured areas of roofs.
- Step 10:** Apply Gold & Purple Glitter to rooftops.
- Step 11:** Glue front and back together. Insert Snap-In Light.

### SKULL SMOKER - DH-1725 & BASE 1364

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, P50 Weathered Wood by Ceramichrome

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-23 Bone, DH-37 Cream, DH-8 Black, DH-25 Teal, DH-49 Premier Gold, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-27 Midnight Blue

- Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black. Apply one even coat of Weathered Wood to skull only, let dry. Paint on one thick coat of Bone over skull without overlapping strokes. Let dry.
- Step 2:** Drybrush Cream lightly over skull. Use a wash of Teal to shade skull around eyes and mouth. Paint knife Gold. Fill in skull's eye with Black.
- Step 3:** Drybrush rocks and base Light Grey. Shade rocks and base with Teal, Country Blue, Midnight Blue and Black. Lightly drybrush over with Cream.

### WOLF SMOKER - DH-1729 & DH-1323 INCENSE HOLDER

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer

**DOC HOLIDAY COLORS:** DH-29 White, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-37 Cream, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-8 Black, DH-25 Teal, DH-10 Mustard

- Step 1:** Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush wolf and rock heavy with Light Grey.
- Step 2:** Add a wash of Teal to belly, nose and back of legs on wolf. Add a wash of Black to back, front of legs, nose, under eyes, top of head and ears on wolf.
- Step 3:** Shade rock with washes of Teal, Country Blue and Mustard.
- Step 4:** Drybrush rock, wolf's belly, back of legs, lip of tail, face and around eyes with Cream.
- Step 5:** Shade rock with Black. Paint wolf's eyes Mustard with Black pupils and Black nose.
- Step 6:** Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.
