

DH1986 - DRIFTWOOD WHITE-TAIL DEER
MATERIAL NEEDED: Greenware, Various Brushes, SP08-Matte Spray, SP05-Doc's Glue

ACRYLIC STAINS NEEDED: DH08-Black, DH25-Toast, DH12-Leather Brown, DH29-White, DH42-Dark Gray, DH34-Soft Brown, DH33-Deep Beige, DH10-Mustard

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03. Basecoat entire piece Black.
STEP 2: Wetbrush entire piece with Real Brown first, and then Leather Brown. Wetbrush deer and wood again with Toast. Add Mustard to same brush and highlight deer.
STEP 3: Wetbrush inside ears, around eyes and muzzle, under sides and front of neck on deer's with White. Paint eyes Toast with Black pupils and a White dot for highlight. Paint noses Black.
STEP 4: Wetbrush wood lightly with Dark Gray and then highlight with Soft Brown. Shade entire piece with Black. Spray with Matte Sealer.

ANTLERS: Basecoat Deep Beige and wetbrush first with Soft Brown and then Cream. Glue antlers in place on deer's head with Doc's Glue.

DH 1975 - LYNX

MATERIALS NEEDED: Glitter, SP08-Matte Spray, SP04-Snow It, AT01-Black Antiquing

ACRYLIC STAINS NEEDED: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH37-Cream, DH42-Dark Gray, DH19-Light Gray, DH25-Toast, DH30-Country Blue, DH14-Rose, DH12-Leather Brown, DH43-Teal, DH44-Blue Suede, DH45-Shadow Green

STEP 1: Clean and fire bisque to cone 03.
STEP 2: Basecoat lynx and wood Dark Gray. Antiquing both with Black Antiquing and wipe off with a soft cloth.
STEP 3: Wet brush again with Dark Gray. Apply washes of Toast and Light Gray. Wet brush White around areas on face (refer to photo). Shade areas to give depth with Black. Paint nose Rose and shade with Leather Brown.
STEP 4: Apply washes of Country Blue, Toast to log. Highlight with Cream. Shade with Black. Paint Black lines in wood.
STEP 5: Basecoat pine trees with Teal and highlight with Blue Suede. Shade with Shadow Green.
STEP 6: Paint rabbit White and shade with Black around nose, ears, and areas touching snow. Paint eyes with Medium Brown.
STEP 7: Spray with Matte Spray.
STEP 8: Apply Snow-It to snow areas and sprinkle with ultra fine glitter.

DH1948 - DOG WITH DUCK STEIN

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, SP02-Mask It, SP08-Matte Spray Sealer, AT04-Red Brown Translucent

ACRYLIC STAINS NEEDED: DH16-Flaxon Yellow, DH25-Toast, DH35-Powder Blue, DH37-Cream, DH29-White, DH30-Country Blue, DH09-Real Brown, DH10-Mustard, DH08-Black, DH27-Midnight Blue, DH38-Grass Green, DH45-

Shadow Green, DH42-Dark Gray, DH22-Christmas Red, DH12-Leather Brown, DH03-True Orange, DH37-Cream

STEP 1: Airbrush plain sections and sky of stein with Flaxon Yellow. Add Toast to Flaxon Yellow and airbrush rims and lower sky. Airbrush upper sky with Powder Blue, gradually fading into horizon.
STEP 2: Paint clouds with washes of Cream, White, Toast and Country Blue.
STEP 3: Basecoat big dog and dog on lid Flaxon Yellow. Antique with Red Brown translucent. Wetbrush dogs with Flaxon Yellow, highlight with Cream. Shade darker areas on dogs with Toast and Real Brown washes. Paint eyes Mustard; tint with a Toast wash. Paint pupils Black. Paint noses Real Brown; highlighted with Toast.
STEP 4: Paint all remaining areas Black. Paint collar Christmas Red.
STEP 5: Wetbrush water with Midnight Blue. Gradually add White to same brush and wetbrush highlights on water. Wetbrush "greenery" with Grass Green, then highlight with Mustard and Flaxon Yellow. Shade with a Shadow Green wash.
STEP 6: Highlight "black" dogs lightly with Dark Gray.
STEP 7: Basecoat duck with Black. Wet-brush ducks head with Shadow Green. Add Cream to same brush and wet-brush head again. Wet-brush neck with Leather Brown. Paint White ring around neck. Wet-brush rest of duck with Real Brown and then with Medium Brown. Wet-brush belly and underneath wing with Cream. Wet-brush feet with Rust and add Cream to same brush and highlight feet. Wet-brush beak Mustard with a Toast wash. Duck's eyes are Black with a White highlight. Shade piece with Black.
STEP 8: Apply Mask-It to fired gold areas. Let dry then spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.

DH1940, DH1941, DH1942, DH1943, DH1944, DH1945, DH1949 WILDLIFE CHESS SET

MATERIALS NEEDED: Doc's Glue SP05, Chess Board, Matte Spray SP08, True Brown Antiquing AT03, Red Brown Antiquing AT04

ACRYLIC STAINS: Black - 08, White - 29, Cream - 37, Toast - 25, Sand - 21, Soft Brown - 34, Rose - 14, True Red - 04, Country Blue - 30, Mustard - 10, Leather Brown - 12, Medium Brown - 18, Bone - 23, Beige - 11, Light Gray - 19, Dark Gray - 42, Terra Cotta - 24, Flaxon Yellow - 16, Blue Suede - 44, Turquoise - 40, Midnight Blue - 27, Teal - 43, True Orange - 03

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.
STEP 2: Basecoat side boards Sand and corner rocks Black. Antiquing side boards with Red Brown and wipe off with soft cloth.
STEP 3: Wet-brush side boards with Sand and highlight with Bone. Paint rocks, sticks and leaves Black. Wet-brush rocks with Dark Gray (do same with corner rocks on base) and apply washes of Country Blue, Toast, Real Brown and Mustard. Wet-brush Light Gray to rocks and shade with Black.
STEP 4: Wet-brush sticks with Real Brown, highlight with Medium Brown. Wet-brush leaves True Red, shade with True Orange and tip leaves with Flaxon Yellow. Shade all areas with Real Brown and then Black.
STEP 5: Basecoat two buffalo Cream, highlight with White. Shade with Toast. Paint wood with Deep Beige

and paint washes of Real Brown, Toast, and Cream. Shade with Black.

Step 6: Paint two buffalo with Real Brown, highlight with washes of Leather Brown. Paint horns Cream. Shade with Black. Basecoat wood Black. Paint washes of Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue, Toast. Shade with Black.
Step 7: Paint 2 eagles White and wood Deep Beige. Paint beak Mustard; highlight with Flaxon Yellow, shade with Toast. Shade eyes with Mustard and Toast. Paint eyes Mustard, shade with Toast and pupils Black. Paint rocks Black, then paint washes of Real Brown, Toast and Mustard to rocks. Wet-brush Cream on rocks and shade with Black.

Step 8: Paint two eagles Toast and paint washes of Leather Brown on eagle. Tip feathers with Flaxon Yellow. Paint beak with Flaxon Yellow and shade with Dark Gray. Paint eyes Mustard; add wash of Toast and paint pupil Black. Shade eyes and beak Black. Paint rocks Black and add washes of Real Brown, Mustard and Country Blue. Wet-brush Cream and shade rocks with Black.
Step 9: Paint two wolves Light Gray. Add washes of Toast on nose and eyes. Wet-brush Light Gray and highlight with White. Paint mouth with Rose. Shade areas for depth with Black. Paint wood with Deep Beige then put washes of Real Brown, Toast and Cream. Shade with Black.
Step 10: Paint two wolves Black. Wet-brush Dark Gray. Add washes of Real Brown and Black. Highlight areas around eyes and ears and areas on neck with White. Paint mouth with True Red. Shade with Black. Paint wood Black. Add washes of Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue and Toast. Shade with Black.

Step 11: Paint one bear Deep Beige and antique with True Brown. Wipe off with a soft cloth. Wet-brush Medium Brown and highlight with Soft Brown. Shade with Real Brown and Black. Paint wood Deep Beige then add washes of Real Brown, Toast, and Cream. Shade with Black.
Step 12: Paint one bear and wood Black. Highlight bear with Dark Gray. Paint washes of Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue, and Toast. Shade with Black.
Step 13: Paint one cougar Mustard. Paint washes of Toast and Terra Cotta on face. Paint White around eyes, mouth, neck and ears. Paint nose Rose and shade with Black. Paint wood Deep Beige and paint washes of Real Brown, Toast and Cream. Shade with Black.

Step 14: Paint one cougar and wood Black. Highlight cougar with Dark Gray. Paint wood with washes of Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue and Toast. Shade with Black.

Step 15: Paint snow owl White and paint markings with Black. Paint nose Dark Gray, eyes Black and outline with Mustard. Paint wood with Deep Beige. Paint washes of Real Brown, Toast and Cream. Shade with Black.
Step 16: Paint barn owl with Toast on back and paint markings with Black. Paint front of owl with White. Paint eyes Black and outline with Toast. Paint wood Black. Add washes of Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue, and Toast. Shade with Black.

Step 17: Paint 16 disks(bases) with Cream. Add washes of Soft Brown and Medium Brown.
Step 18: Paint 16 bases with Blue Suede, add washes of Turquoise, Teal and Midnight Blue.
Step 19: Spray all pieces with Matte Spray.
Step 20: Glue figurines on bases with Doc's Glue.

DH1974 - THREE RUNNING DRIFTWOOD HORSE
MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, various brushes,

solvent, SP08-Matte Spray

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH09-Real Brown, DH25-Toast, DH18-Medium Brown, DH12-Leather Brown, DH42-Dark Gray, DH19-Light Gray, DH37-Cream, DH14-Rose, AT01-Black Antiquing

Step 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.
Step 2: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush wood and middle horse with Real Brown. Paint washes of Toast, Medium Brown and wood.
Step 3: Wetbrush middle horse with Leather Brown and highlight with Black. Shade mane and around face, eyes, and mouth with Toast. Wetbrush grey dapple with Dark Gray and highlight with Light Gray. Apply spots with Light Gray washes. Shade horse with Black.
Step 4: Wetbrush the horse on the end with Real Brown. Highlight with Toast, shade with Real Brown. Wet-brush light areas with Rose.
Step 5: Paint eyes with Medium Brown and pupil's Black. Paint white markings with White on horses face.
Step 6: Antique whole piece with Black antiquing. Wipe off with a soft cloth. Wipe back off with solvent.
Step 7: Spray with Matte Spray.
